Mahaiwe Presents Jonny Lang Blues Concert

Great Barrington, Mass.— Mahaiwe Performing Arts Center will present Grammy Award-winning blues guitarist and singer-songwriter Jonny Lang on Sunday, June 8 at 7:00pm. “I’m very excited to welcome this blues phenomenon to the Mahaiwe stage for the first time. It promises to be an unforgettable night,” said Mahaiwe Executive Director Beryl Jolly. Tickets (\$30 to \$79) go on sale to Mahaiwe members on Friday, February 21 at 12 noon and to the public on Wednesday, February 26 at 12 noon.

Jonny Lang is a blues, gospel, and rock singer, songwriter, guitarist, and recording artist. As a 12 year old, he began a musical journey in Fargo, North Dakota that has brought him to points across the globe. He mastered his skills at an amazingly young age, topping the Billboard charts with his first album, *Lie to Me*, in 1996 when he was only 16. Over the years, he has shared the stage with the Rolling Stones, B.B. King, Aerosmith, Sting, and Buddy Guy, who he continues to tour with today.

With the release of his newest album, *Fight For My Soul* (2013), Lang says he is entering a chapter where he has found his true voice. The album defies categorization by a single genre. It is defined by textured arrangements, broad worldview, gorgeous vocal melodies, and expressive guitar playing. “Much of what I’ve experienced through music and life in

general is in these songs. I really like reaching out and connecting with people. For me, this is what it's all about. It keeps it fresh with different experiences every day," said Lang. "One of my goals is the music can be a blessing to the people listening to it in some way. And if *Fight For My Soul* can help somebody by making them feel better or that they're not alone, that's my idea of success for this album."

The Mahaiwe is located at 14 Castle Street in Great Barrington, Massachusetts. Box office hours are Wednesday through Saturday from noon to 6:00pm and three hours before show times.
